

Redevelopment of Joondalup Health Campus



Joondalup Health Campus is the biggest hospital in Perth's northern corridor with 660 beds, including 514 public beds and 146 private beds.

Owned by the State and operated by Ramsay Health Care, the campus has treated public patients on behalf of the State since 1996 as part of a successful public private partnership.

In addition Ramsay has a private facility on the campus.

The population of Wanneroo and Joondalup is predicted to increase by almost 50,000 (11%) within the next five years and by 110,000 (27%) over the next decade.

Serving one of the fastest growing areas in Australia, this world class hospital continues to treat record numbers of patients.

Fast Facts

In 2015/16, the hospital had:

- 98,432 Emergency Department (ED) presentations, an increase of 33% compared to five years ago, making it one of the busiest EDs in the country.
- Twice the number of ambulances arriving at the ED as five years ago.
- 74,032 hospital admissions, 7% more than the previous year and nearly 60% more than five years ago.
- 4,279 babies delivered, a jump of 17% on the previous year and a more than 80% increase over the past five years.



Improving Health Care for the Northern Suburbs

The Government and Ramsay Health Care have jointly funded several major redevelopments between 2009 and 2013, expanding and improving services for public and private patients.

In June 2016 the Telethon Children's Ward, jointly funded by Telethon, the State Government and Ramsay Health Care, opened on time and under budget.

Construction will soon start on a jointly funded \$7.1 million Mental Health Observation Area in the Emergency Department, with \$5.1 million contributed by the Government.

Our Commitment

A Liberal Government will invest around \$140 million to further and significantly expand Joondalup Hospital. The Government will work in partnership with Ramsay Health Care to deliver:

- 90 new public hospital beds
- Between 25-30 new public mental health beds
- Eight new operating theatres
- Expansion of the emergency department
- Expansion of the public and staff car park
- Expansion of the central plant unit

Ramsay will also fund a significant and concurrent expansion in private capacity.

A re-elected Liberal Government will immediately commence negotiations with Ramsay Health Care and sign relevant contracts as soon as possible. It is anticipated that the additional beds and new facilities will come on stream by 2021.

The long standing partnership initiated between the Government and Ramsay Health Care has served residents of the northern suburbs well.

Labor Party policy opposes such partnerships, leaving the future of Joondalup Health Campus uncertain should Labor be elected.
