
Your Excellency

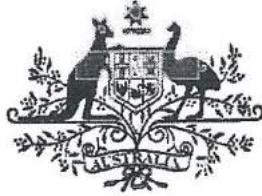
I am writing to advise Your Excellency that the Honourable Kevin Rudd MP has today been elected leader of the Federal Parliamentary Labor Party.

I therefore recommend that Your Excellency send for Mr Rudd and ask him to accept appointment to the office of Prime Minister.

I wish to resign the office of Prime Minister with effect from the appointment of Mr Rudd to the office. As Mr Rudd may wish current Ministers to remain in office, my resignation is intended to leave ministerial appointments other than my own unaffected until such time as Mr Rudd, as Prime Minister, may advise Your Excellency otherwise.
